



Mission with A Vision Organization is a girl's rescue programme started in 1997. The programme is currently facing some challenges in supporting our 128 girls in our two safehouses located in Narok town and Nairasirasa village.

Our mandate is to give a safe home to girls escaping FGM and forced early marriage and also ensure they get an education.

As a way of raising funds to ensure the girls get the much-needed services, Patrick the executive director and his wife Josephine have organized a charity walk. They will be walking from Narok to Nairobi via Ngong covering a distance of 168 km in 13 days as per the map below. Their target is to raise funds to cover the following:-

- 1. Safehouse support for two years- (food, medication, salaries for staff etc)- \$ 60,000
- 2. School fees for 50 girls for three years- \$ 52,500

We are looking for your support per kilometre. If you wish to give \$1 per kilometre that would translate to a total of \$168, if \$10 per kilometre that would make a total of \$1,680, and if it is \$100 per kilometre then that would be a total of \$16,800. You can pledge any amount per kilometre. Let's join hands and give our girls hope.

In October 2022 Patrick and Josephine did the same walk and were able to raise a good amount of money which enabled us to clear fees for 36 girls, purchase food for the girls. install a solar water pump system which now provide water to the Rescue center and the girls 8 acre farm. "The walk was not easy especially between Suswa and Mai mahiu because of the scorching sun. The other challenging section is climbing the escapement from Mai mahiu to Limuru. We are praying for good health to tackle this two difficult sections. The joy of seeing more girls get education is worth the swollen feet and uncomfortable nights in school classrom floors," says Josephine.
